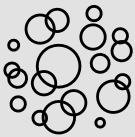
Cisco in Australia

How Cisco is investing in digital transformation

Cisco's Country Digital Acceleration (CDA) program has over 1,600 digitisation projects and is active across 50 countries.

In 2019, Cisco announced the CDA investment program in Australia to work with government, community and industry organisations to develop and fund digital acceleration projects.

Cisco is focused on fast tracking Australia's digital agenda through innovation and accelerating the adoption of emerging technologies, such as AI and Cybersecurity. This supports GDP growth, creating new jobs, advancing industry and uplifting skills and education.



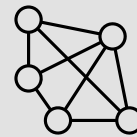
Innovation Central Brisbane

Innovation Central Brisbane (ICB) helps Queensland industry create digital solutions to address commercial and operational challenges. ICB connects researchers and students to industry in an experimentation space equipped with the latest Cisco technology.



Advancing Healthy Ageing

Cisco and UniSC have appointed a Research Chair in Health Productivity, Dr Alison Craswell. Together they are establishing a Health Productivity lab to drive innovations in the health and aged care sectors.



Cisco-UQ Centre for Future Networks

Cisco and the University of Queensland is working to establish a centre focused on development and validation of future of networking capabilities and architectures for education, industry sectors & market transitions (e.g. renewables, critical minerals).



Rail Level Crossing Safety Project

Cisco is working to enhance the technology capabilities of the rolling stock fleet by connecting locomotives and enabling real-time location tracking alongside forward-facing cameras. The focus of the project is to analyse and improve the safety profile of thousands of level crossings across Australia.



Trust, Retail & Logistics Research Chair

Cisco and QUT have appointed a Research Chair in Trust, Retail and Logistics, Dr Nadine Ostern, to explore research topics related to logistics, retail trust, consumer engagement, security and sustainability.



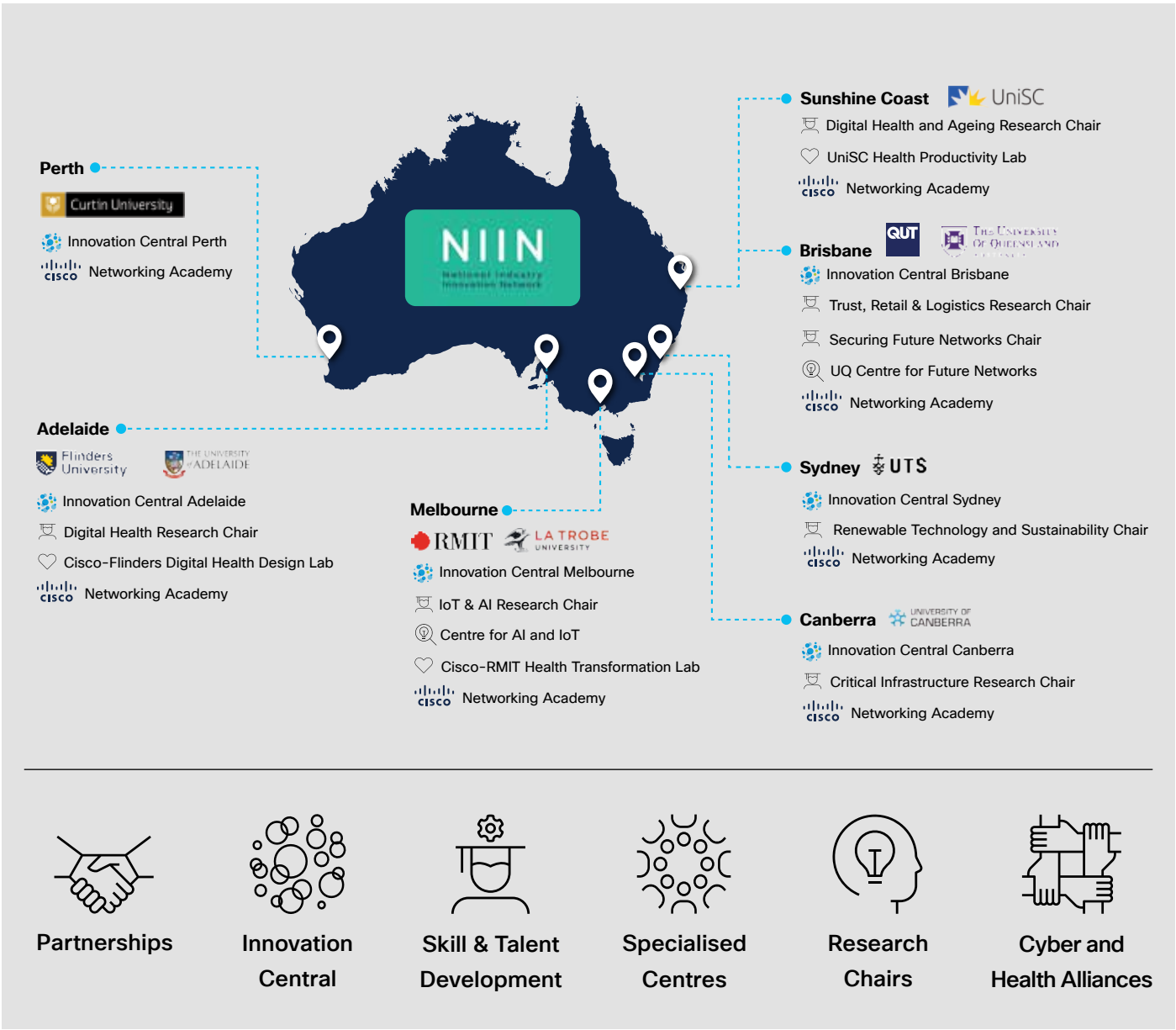
Health Living Lab & Digital Twin

Establishment of a digital healthcare capability (networks and infrastructure) focused on proving how investment in digital can materially improve the performance of the health system.

Partnerships making a difference

The National Industry Innovation Network (NIIN) is a collaborative vehicle for digitally transforming industries and accelerating innovation to generate large-scale economic and societal impact. The NIIN was founded by global technology leader Cisco in direct response to many of the challenges Australia faces in terms of realising the economic potential of digital technologies and improving collaboration between industry and universities.

Since 2020, the NIIN has grown to become one of Australia’s largest industry–university innovation network, now comprising Innovation Centrals, University Research Chairs, Specialist Centres, dedicated Alliances in Health and in Cybersecurity, targeted skills and talent initiatives, and a program engaging former Cisco engineers and business leaders in academia.



Supporting our communities and visitor economy

Cisco combines technology, people and the broader community to address society's greatest challenges.

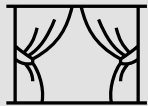
Major priorities include:

- Reaching Net Zero across our value chain by 2040 and incorporating circular design into 100% of new Cisco products and packaging by FY25.

Promoting diversity in tech

Cisco Australia has been recognised as the #1 Best Place to Work for five consecutive years. Cisco promotes diversity through programs such as Girls in ICT Day and Women Rock-IT, which profile stories of successful women pursuing careers in IT.



Lifting access to the performing arts

Opera Queensland partnered with Cisco to launch the Singing Queensland program, bringing pitch-perfect opera to classrooms via interactive technology.



Supporting Orange Sky's mission

Cisco has expanded the technology infrastructure in Orange Sky's new HQ which is an international hub for Australia and New Zealand operations where vans and pods are built, research and development is conducted, and thousands of volunteers are supported each week.



Cisco Olympic and Paralympic Legacy

Cisco has been a technology provider for the Olympics and Paralympics since 2012, having served as network and security partner for London 2012, Rio 2016, Tokyo 2020 and Paris 2024.

Cisco has committed to LA2028 and stands ready to play its part as Queensland prepares to host the 2032 Olympic Games.

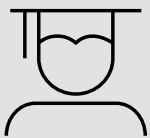


Building Queensland skills and future talent

Cisco Networking Academy is an IT skills-to-jobs program offering digital skills training through strong public-private partnerships, high-quality curriculum, and inclusive workforce development programs.

The Networking Academy had 3,213 students from Queensland in FY24. Students originated from a range of institutions including UQ, TAFE Queensland, QUT, UniSC and University of Southern Queensland.

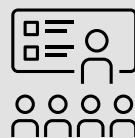

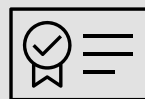
